3 Your Information

3.1 Collection

The Company may collect, store and use the following types of personal information:

- IP address
- Information about your computer
- Website visit statistics (e.g. frequency and duration of visits to our website)
- Name
- Email address
- Phone number
- Website URLs
- Profile information (e.g. pictures, interests, relationship status)
- Transaction information (e.g. types of products and services purchased, purchase dates)
- Communications sent through our website
- Other information you may choose to send us

3.2 Use

The Company may use the information for the following reasons:

- Administer our website and business
- To keep our website secure and prevent fraud
- Verify compliance with Company policies and government regulations
- Communications with you (e.g. email, newsletters, phone calls)
- To complete business transactions with you (e.g. purchases, invoicing, returns, support, complaints)
- Provide third parties with anonymous statistical information on the use of our website
- To personalize our website for you

3.3 Disclosure

Except as provided for in this policy, we will not, without your permission, disclose personal information to any third party.

We may disclose your personal information to Company employees, officers, professional advisors, insurers, agents, suppliers and sub-contractors insofar as reasonably necessary for the purposes set forth in this policy.

We may disclose your personal information:

- To the extent required by law
- In connection with ongoing legal proceedings
- In order to establish, exercise or defend our legal rights
- To the purchaser, or prospective purchaser, of any business or asset we are, or may be contemplating, selling.

3.4 Retaining

Your personal information will not be kept for longer than is necessary for the purposes set forth in this policy.

You may request, in writing, that we remove your personal information at any time.

We may retain personal information:

- To the extent required by law
- In connection with ongoing legal proceedings
- In order to establish, exercise or defend our legal rights.

3.5 Security

We will take all reasonable technical and organizational precautions to prevent the loss, misuse or alteration of your personal information.

You acknowledge that the transmission of information over the Internet is inherently insecure, and we cannot guarantee the security of data sent over the internet.

You are responsible for keeping the password you use for accessing our website confidential; we will not ask you for your password except when you log into our website.

4 International Data Transfer

6 Cookies
